Reservations are already being made for the Women's Conference, February 19, at Scotts Hill.

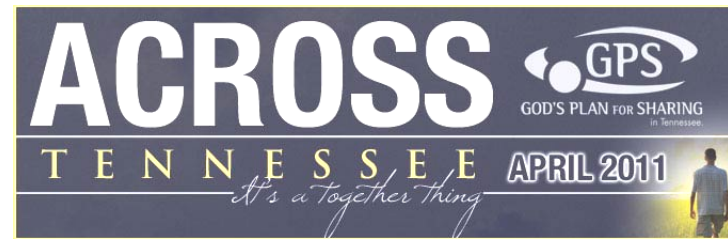
After the holidays and cold weather, attendance is back up at Pastors' Conference.
